



Clinical Documentation Compliance Risk Assessment and Risk Attenuation Planning

Purpose

A central focus of Clinical Documentation Integrity is to mitigate the risk of errors and omissions, ensure medical necessity and demonstrate outcomes and progress made by clients. Increasingly, payers tie reimbursement to the quality of the documentation. And proper documentation is an expected measure for CCBHCs.

Process

- Web-based planning meeting with leadership/project team
- Review and analyze documents and materials supplied by the organization
- Review state, local and other documentation standards used in local auditing
- Minimum of 4 onsite days to conduct audit (can be provided virtually)
- Provide report of findings and prioritized recommendations for risk attenuation
- Post report consultations and Q&A regarding next steps
- Access to the MTM Services Resource Library
- **Timeframe:** 3 months

Outcomes:

- Significant audit and compliance risk reduction
- Reduction in staff hours generating cost savings
- Improved documentation to support enhanced clinical care
