



SUD Medical Management – Expanding Access & Integrating MAT for CCBHCs

Purpose

CCBHCs are required to provide access to comprehensive substance use disorder (SUD) treatment, including Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT). SUD Medical Management (SMM) can help your team expand medical services to include MAT and integrate clinical and medical services to address individuals with complex needs.

Process

- Assessment of current medical services and delivery gaps
- Up to 8 online meetings to implement SMM every 2-4 weeks
- Up to 10 hours of specialty consultation based on agency needs
- 1 hour post-implementation meeting to review outcomes
- Final Report highlighting the changes completed and areas to address
- Access to the MTM Services Resource Library
- **Timeframe:** 9-12 months

Outcomes:

- Rapid access to MAT services and integrated co-occurring treatment
- Decreased utilization of EDs and CJS involvement for SUD/co-occurring clients
- Improved consumer and family satisfaction
